A talk by Paul Pattison FSA its Senior Properties Historian.

Paul will describe the recent project at Richborough, which was the entrance point for the Roman Emperor Claudius to land his invasion force in 43AD.

The project included excavating the amphitheatre site, building a new museum, and the simulation of the timber gateway to the Claudian fort – shown above.

This defended area allowed 40,000 soldiers, with their supplies and equipment, to land and begin their invasion of Britain. Later it developed into a thriving port town, adorned with a huge monumental arch.
